

METLINK GREAT TRANSPORT RACE

Race rules

- All participants in a team must register on the morning at race HQ together, by 8.30am. If a team is late, they will be penalised.
- Stick together. Teams must be together at all times. Teams splitting up will be disqualified.
- Information sharing between teams is not permitted. Keep your answers confidential until they are collected at race HQ.
- If a team or team member need to pull out of the race, the team supervisor must contact the race coordinator immediately. The contact mobile number will be provided to you on race day.
- Teams must travel by foot or approved local public transport – trains, trams and buses. Any team seen using another form of transportation will be disqualified.
- No running or jogging is allowed on train station platforms, at tram and bus stops or at any stage between pit stops. Any team members seen running or jogging will receive a time penalty.
- Each adult supervisor must have a fully-charged mobile phone. The number will be recorded by event organisers to contact them if necessary.
- All road and pedestrian rules and signals must be followed. Always use pedestrian crossings where available. Team members must behave responsibly and cautiously around roads and traffic. Time penalties will apply for risky behaviour.
- No bad language. Time penalties will apply for bad language. Metlink GTR staff can disqualify or penalise teams that behave inappropriately.
- Keep your public transport ticket on you at all times.
- Be polite to the Metlink GTR photographers. Photographers may follow your team.
- Listen to and follow the instructions of staff at race HQ and pit stops.
- Students must follow team supervisors' instructions at all times.
- Students must wear provided Metlink GTR t-shirts as a form of identification.
- Students must remember that they are representing their school and it is important to show courtesy to others. This means offering seats to pregnant, elderly and disadvantaged passengers on trains, trams and buses. Keep doorways clear both on public transport and at location entrances.
- All rubbish must be disposed of responsibly or taken away with you from race HQ, pit stops, trains, trams and buses.
- The judges' decision is final. The top five teams from each heat will advance to the grand final.
